Pray that I won't be bitter about my exaggerated charges and 20 plus years in federal prison I am facing for drugs, but to look beyond myself and see the ministry God has for me to encourage others in their walk with Christ. Prison is now my mission field. I am a very passive quiet person so I need boldness and encouragement from the Lord and I pray that He gives me the words to speak light into these dark prisons."

A note from a thankful inmate: "I just wanted to write and say thank you for sending (Volunteer), to WTRJ to read some bible verses to us. This was a huge blessing to me. I have been in jail since March 10<sup>th</sup> and found Jesus here... I have so much stress from losing my career to concerns of my family not having food to eat but thankfully, I now have Jesus. Your volunteer felt like a gift from God in this time of need. He is so full of the Holy Spirit that it overflows onto us here. It was so nice hearing him read from the bible and talk about simple everyday things in his life like his cucumbers growing in his garden. Thank you and thanks to God for sending him our way. God Bless!"

**From Teresa (Office):** God recently used one of you mightily to speak peace into my life regarding my brother who is battling terminal cancer. To God be the Glory and thank you for "walking and talking" this lovely walk of faith!!!

We are constantly hearing about the encouragement that your visits, prayers and ministry brings to those incarcerated. It really is priceless. As you see above, great is the need for us to bring the Gospel and also to lift in prayer those that are saved. Many incarcerated are filled with shame and need the redemption that only Christ can provide.
